This garden is nestled into the bends of the River Seiont outside Caernarfon, on a site of industrial significance, having been previously run as a fish farm and having the remains of both a pottery and a corn mill. The owners, Sarah Edgar and Gerry Downing have created over many years a productive wildlife friendly garden which is beautiful but not over planted or manicured.

Sunday 8th Sept 10.30 am, Visit to Treborth Botanic Garden LL57 2RQ

2 minutes from Plas Cadnant, parking round the buildings and more in the Athletics facilities further up the lane.

The Botanic Gardens are part of Bangor University, the Curator Natalie Chivers and members of Friends of Treborth will show us round. The current garden, started in 1960 occupies a unique location by the Menai Strait and encompasses meadows, woodland and rock gardens with densely planted glasshouses. Features within the garden relate to an earlier Joseph Paxton design.
