Visit to Morben Hall, Derwenlas, Machynlleth

Wednesday 10th May 2023 at 2.00p.m. £10 per person



This visit, by kind permission of the current owners David and Christine Roberts, is an opportunity to explore the grounds of a small gentry estate, home of the Owen family in the 17th century. It was a hunting estate in the 19th and early 20th centuries, with its own pack of harriers, whose exploits are described by Captain Newton Wynne Apperley in 'A Hunting Diary', published in 1926. The surroundings of Morben Hall have changed remarkably little over time and after a short introduction to the history of the estate there will be the opportunity to explore the grounds and woodland walks where the bluebells should be at their best. *Light refreshments will be provided.*

DIRECTIONS: Entrance to drive, signposted Morben Hall/ Llety Morben, is on the A487, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile south of Derwenlas and 1 mile north of Morben Isaf Holiday Park. *Post Code: SY20 8SR* **Parking at the Hall is extremely limited**, so we may have to allocate car sharing from a nearby layby.
